(b) If there is only one Additional Chief Engineer posted in a Zone, then he shall be the CPIO. If there is no Additional Chief Engineer authorized or posted, the senior most Director/ Staff officer shall be the CPIO.

(c) In case of non-availability of the designated CPIO or the CAPIO, the duties will be discharged by the officiating incumbent, without the need for issuance of any separate orders to this effect.
